



## Are You 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Ready?

**Please bring the following supplies the first day of school.**

- 1 Organizing system for loose papers (ex. folders, accordion file)
- 4 Composition books (bound, not spiral)
- 1 Pkg loose-leaf (lined) notebook paper
- 1 Pkg graph paper ( $\frac{1}{4}$  inch squares, double-sided is best)
- 3 Large or 6 small glue sticks
- 1 Pkg 3X5 cards
- 2 Pkgs 3X3 Post-it Notes
- 24 #2 pencils or a mechanical pencil with extra lead (to be replenished)
- 3 Black ink pens
- 1 Large eraser
- 1 Ruler (metric and standard – flexible & transparent if possible)
- 2 Correcting pens or pencils
- 2 Black “Sharpie” fine point pen (to be replenished)
- 1 Set colored pencils – 24 or more colors
- 1 Pair scissors
- 3 Highlighters – (multi-colored set)
- 1 Large box of tissue (Bring to HomeBase.)
- 1 Set of inexpensive earbuds or headphones for iPad use
- 1 Three-ring binder with at least 1-inch diameter rings  
OR a multi-pocket folder (This binder or folder will be used for **math** only.)
- 5 Dividers for math binder (not needed if using pocket folder)
- 1 **OPTIONAL:** Scientific calculator (with square root and exponent keys)  
**Note:** *Scientific and graphing calculators are installed on the school iPads. 8<sup>th</sup> graders wanting their own handheld calculator should purchase a TI-30X-IIS or equivalent. Honors Algebra students who wish to purchase a graphing calculator should buy a TI-83 PLUS. Remember, calculator purchase is **optional**. (Please e-mail Mrs. Tomayer if you have calculator questions.)*  
**Students will not be allowed to use a cell phone calculator during class.**
